

National sports rules

Art. 98.

All electronic basketed pigeons participating in an international or a national race will be obliged to carry a rubber ring. The pigeons who participate in these races and be mechanically basketed carry two rubber rings.

For those who participate in inter-provincial or provincial competitions must follow the guidelines of the organizer this subject will be followed.

The first pigeon arrived from every fancier in each category will be required and identified checked. Failing that, they will make a second after the first inspection are classified. If this negligence multiple pigeons are concerned, these, after the first inspection, classified, from second to second, in order of clocking. If no inspection was conducted timings will all be cancelled. If the check fails is clocked, the pigeon may be classified on the clocking of the control (see the orders of § 6, 7 and 8). For lack of a control device must have the control rubber rings to be returned along with the main unit.

Apart from the first clocked pigeon whose control rubber ring within 10 minutes in the main unit is been clocked. With electronic registration is just a rubber ring of the first clocked pigeon obliged to control (the other rings in the association must be brought). These requirements are minimal. The organizers are empowered to make them even more stringent, eg. by the obligation to check all the pigeons. However, these rules must be submitted for approval to the national sports committee in anticipation of its annual meeting.

For international, national, inter-provincial and provincial races, the use of clocks that the hour of clocking state with a prick of a needle are prohibited, both main unit and control unit. For international and domestic flights are only QUARTZ electronic systems and devices as allowed master clock (Quartz clock control devices as well). Control timing may, at its own risk, approved mechanical devices occur, which may however NEVER be considered in case of failure of the master clock.
